Full Day Training

Notebook Software – Novice

Part # 1T100L

Introduce your education staff to the power of Notebook Software. This full day course will bring your team up to speed in Notebook. It will introduce them to the hardware, insure they are familiar with all the components of the software and show them how to use it effectively in the classroom to bring interactivity and engaging lessons to their students. This class utilizes a "hands-on" approach. It is recommended that the course be held in a lab setting or with participants having access to laptops to gain the most benefit from the instruction. There will be plenty of assimilation and interaction time to insure the successful implementation of your new technology in the classroom. Notebook Software Advanced – Intermediate to advanced

Part # 1T110L

This course is not for the novice user. If your teachers are intermediate users and wanting to expand their skill base, this is the course for them. This course focuses on tips for designing effective lessons using Notebook software. Participants will learn how to build Interactive lesson activities by using Flash, attaching sound, using hide and reveal and object animation. They will learn how to incorporate rich-media into lesson activities. They will also learn how to use the record features of Notebook. Hands-on activities and practice will be employed to make sure the learners gain confidence with newly found skills. Participants should have one year of experience on their SMART boards prior to course.

Twenty-first Century Classroom Skills Quick Start – Novice

Part # 1T120L

Combining some of our most popular offerings to get your teachers off and running with their new technology, this class offers Notebook Software 1. In addition, there is a quick Response training as well as an overview of Math Tools for Notebook software. This one-day professional development will give your teachers an overview of all the technology that is available today and give them the tools for basic functionality.

Half Day Training

Notebook Software 1 Training – Novice

Part # 2T200L

Bring our Certified Smart Consultant and trainer to your facility to familiarize your faculty members with the basic functioning of the SMART Interactive White Board. This class will expose members to the hardware, software and basic functionality of the software. It includes activities, training manuals and hands-on practice. Teachers will need to have access to a computer loaded with the software during the training session.

Notebook Software 2 Training – Intermediate

Part # 2T210L

This is the second part of Notebook Software. In this course, our SMART Certified Education Consultant will begin with a review of Notebook basics. She will teach participants how to work with objects in Notebook as well as exploring ink aware applications. It includes sharing notebook files and using Word, Excel and Powerpoint with Notebook software. This course includes training manual and hands on activities. Participants must have a computer with Notebook software available for the class. In addition, students should have access to Microsoft Word, Excel and Powerpoint for practice applications.

Notebook Design and Lesson Delivery – Intermediate to Advanced

Part # 2T220L

This class will look with intent at design elements used in preparing excellent Notebook lessons. We will look at print, fonts, color images and effective layout in terms of design. Organization and planning for sophisticated delivery will be another focus. Participants will learn how to create and customize themes and backgrounds. They will learn how to add title pages, lesson plans and objectives to the front of notebook files.

It will also include delivery tips.

Interactive Lesson Planning and Delivery – Intermediate to Adv

Part # 2T230L

This upper level course starts out focusing on Basic Design considerations and moves into helping teachers focus on Instructional Design including targeting age and ability, learning styles, special needs, enabling assessment and allowing students to review and reflect. It will also focus on times and ways to effectively use the SMART interactive white board in the classroom. This course will look at games and interactive activities that can be modified with teacher material to be used in many different applications. We will also explore the Smart Exchange and other resource locations.

SMART Response – all levels

Part # 2T240L

Formerly called SENTEO, this course will provide users assistance with setting up SMART Response for their classrooms. It will include learning how to make assessments and how to import grades into an electronic grade book. Learn how to use both formative and summative assessments and interpret data. Participants should come with class lists and two quizzes to be prepared for interactivity. Teachers will need laptops with SMART Response software as well as Notebook.

SMART Technical Training – For Support and Technical Staff

Part # 2T250T

Need help trouble shooting hardware problems? Half Day Professional Development

Notebook PD – Novice

Part # 2PD300L

This class introduces the hardware and software for classroom use. It explores best practices for classroom application. It is designed to get teachers up and moving with Notebook, making their classrooms more interactive. This course uses “hands – on” practice and gives lots of examples for teachers. This course is packed with great ideas to get new users moving in the right direction without overwhelming them.

Notebook PD -- Intermediate

Part # 2PD310L

This class goes beyond the basics with emphasis on more advanced skills such as page record, linking, adding and converting flash videos, attaching sound clips, and using movie clips as a teaching tool. There are lots of application ideas for the tools in SMART Notebook software. Notebook PD – Advanced

Part # 2PD320L

Have teachers who have been using their SMART Boards for a number of years? This course is the next step. With an emphasis on addressing higher order thinking skills, addressing multiple intelligence and differentiated instruction, your staff is sure to gain new insight on how to use the SMART Interactive white board effectively. Work with Kinesthetic learners, sequential learners, visual learners and Spatial learners while teaching digital literacy. Learn how to create e-Folios, use virtual manipulatives, attach flash files and use videos. ***Participants should have 2 years + experience with a SMART Board.***

Interactive Lesson Building in NB – Novice/ Intermediate

Part # 2PD330L

In this course, participants come armed and ready for action. Teachers will bring already prepared lessons to the class and work with them to add interactivity. We will look at quality lessons on-line. Teachers will collaborate in a lab setting with their peers while the SMART Certified Education Consultant assists with questions, ideas and pointing teachers toward resources. Teachers will come away with real lessons they can use in their own classroom. This is best suited to a lab setting where computers or lap tops and several whiteboards can easily be accessed. ***Ideal for teachers using their SMART Boards during the first year or two.***

Looking for ideas to use higher order thinking skills?? This is the course for you. Look at learning through problem solving instead of direct instruction. It will touch on multiple learning styles and differentiated instruction.

“Just in Time” sessions – Novice to Intermediate

Part # 4PD 410L

These highly customized sessions involve the Education Consultant working with a small group of teachers to look at specific user needs whether this involves trouble shooting or strategy sessions of how to achieve a desired outcome. This can take place after school, during a planning period or lunch hour. Split the time between several groups, as needed. This is an ideal solution for your teachers who may need extra support implementing new technology.

SMART Table – Novice/ Intermediate/ Advanced

Teachers will learn how to set up the SMART Table and customize user options.
